

## **HON. BRADLEY B. LETTS BIO**

The Hon. Bradley B. Letts is the senior resident superior court judge for the 30B Judicial District of the Eighth Division of the Superior Court, serving Haywood and Jackson counties in North Carolina.

Judge Letts received his B.A. in philosophy and economics from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in 1990 and his J.D. from the University of Mississippi School of Law in 1995.

Judge Letts' twenty-five year legal career has spanned a wide array of public service. From 1995 to 1997, Judge Letts served for two years as an Assistant District Attorney with the Office of the District Attorney in Waynesville, North Carolina at which time he was appointed as the Attorney General for the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians between 1997 and 1999. Following this time, Judge Letts served for approximately 9 years as a District Court Judge for the 30B Judicial District in Western North Carolina before serving what is now almost ten years on the bench as Senior Resident Superior Court Judge, 30B Judicial District of the Eighth Division of the Superior Court.
